The Sioux City Art Center is currently accepting entries for its 62nd Juried Art Exhibition. This exhibition continues the Sioux City Art Center's mission of supporting and exhibiting contemporary art from the upper Midwest.

ELIGIBILITY

The exhibition is open to artists 18 years of age and older living in Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Wisconsin. All works must be original, completed in the last two years, and not previously exhibited at the Sioux City Art Center. Accepted works may not be withdrawn by the artist prior to the close of the exhibition and must abide by specifications below.

Cash prizes: First Place \$1,500 Second Place \$500 Third Place \$250

JUROR

Gilbert Vicario has been curator at the Des Moines Art Center since August 2009. From 2004-2009, he was assistant curator of Latin American and Latino art at the Museum of Fine Arts, Houston. In 2006, he was named Commissioner for the International Biennale of Cairo by the U. S. Department of State for the exhibition *Daniel Joseph Martinez: The Fully Enlightened Earth Radiates Disaster Triumphant*.

SPECIFICATIONS

Each artist may up to three works in any media. Electronic artworks must include all necessary equipment. Three-dimensional works may not exceed 150 pounds in weight and 120 inches (10 feet) in any one direction. Installation pieces may not exceed 10 feet in diameter. Two-dimensional work may not exceed 40 pounds in weight and 120 inches (10 feet) in any one direction.

All wall-hung work must be framed and/or equipped with wire or loop hanging devices. If glazed, work must be covered with plexiglas rather than glass. Work will be excluded if it is deemed: to be inappropriate for security or public safety concerns; to be inadequately framed/mounted; or to lack appropriate packing for return shipping. All works must be maintenance free.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- One CD-ROM disk that holds one (1) .jpeg images of up to three (3) of your works. Images must be between 300 and 400 dpi and should be clearly labeled. Video work submitted must be DVD-R. Slides will not be accepted.
- Non-refundable entry fee of \$25 in check or money order.
- Self-addressed stamped envelope if return of CD is desired.
- Completed and signed entry form and notification form.

SHIPPING & RECEIVING

Artists are responsible for transit costs and arrangements of accepted artwork to and from the Sioux City Art Center. A check for return shipping charges for accepted work must be sent in a separate envelope to the Sioux City Art Center by the opening on July 16, 2011, otherwise artwork will be returned C.O.D. C.O.D. shipments to the Art Center will not be accepted. No packing peanuts allowed. The Sioux City Art Center reserves the right to reject submissions with inappropriate packing for return shipping. Work not picked up by October 28, 2011 will be charged \$10 per day for storage.

INSURANCE AND LIABILITY

Indicate the insurance value of all entered works, including those not for sale. The Sioux City Art Center will provide insurance on all works during possession. The Sioux City Art Center will not assume liability for loss or damage during transit; artists are encouraged to secure their own insurance during transit.

PUBLICITY

The Sioux City Art Center reserves the right to photograph all exhibited works and to use these photographs for catalog, educational, and/or publicity purposes. Exhibiting artists will receive five complimentary catalogs.

SALES

Sales to the public are encouraged. The Sioux City Art Center will retain a 30% commission. Prices listed on the entry form must reflect this commission. Prices of accepted works may not be changed.
