I have been collecting from this  
dorsal band area are remarkably  
marked. As the distribution of this  
species is now understood, the center  
of abundance appears to be in British  
Columbia, Washington, Idaho & western  
Montana, with a tongue extending down  
from Washington, in western Oregon and  
into northern California in the Sierras  
& northern Sierra. Perhaps this tongue  
will prove to be a subspecies, sufficiently  
differentiated to warrant recognition of  
status in this species.

The above individuals were found  
under the following conditions: One  
under the bark of a dead fir tree lying  
across a ditch by creek, with occasional  
small pools of water; two under logs  
lying along the creek; one under water  
in leaf mold on creek bottom.
