

# ANNUAL REPORT

July 1, 2010 - June 30, 2011

The Sioux City Art Center is a model public/private partnership between the City of Sioux City and the Art Center Association of Sioux City, with each contributing approximately one-half of the Art Center's annual operating budget. Without this model partnership, the Sioux City Art Center could not achieve the quality programs and services that it provides our community and region.

Among its many accomplishments of the past year, the Art Center adopted its 2011 – 2015 Strategic Plan that lays out a vision for the future. The plan is the result of an extensive planning process including staff, stakeholders and the public. The plan was adopted by both the City of Sioux City's Art Center Board of Trustees and the Art Center Association of Sioux City's Board of Directors. The plan includes a modified mission statement, clarifying our role in enriching our region's quality of life, and dropping support of artists from the statement since it is central to all our programs. In addition, the new vision statement identifies four goals, while the value statement places education as fundamental to our institution. (See mission, vision and value statements on the inside front cover.)

While the mission, vision and value statements have been fine tuned to make them more concise, the Art Center's overarching mission to collect, preserve and interpret art to a broad public through quality programs remains the same.

## Program Highlights

Reflecting its mission, the Art Center's education and exhibition staff presented year-round programs, while also adding 12 new artworks by 12 artists to our Permanent Collection. In addition to presenting 22 exhibitions, the exhibition staff, in order to better serve local artists, dedicated a new Community Gallery in April 2011. All of the Art Center's exhibitions were promoted in the Quarterly Calendar, as well as through a combination of the following:

gallery talks, object labels, didactic panels and brochures. The Art Center's staff also moved forward on its planned major public art project for the Art Center's front lawn by completing a call for entries and selecting three finalists. The tentative dedication date for the project, funded primarily by the M. A. Martin Everist Foundation, is July 2012. Lastly, the Art Center's staff began preparing for its upcoming blockbuster exhibition Leonardo da Vinci: Man Artist Genius/ Man Inventor Genius by visiting the exhibition while it was in Spokane, Washington. The exhibition promises to meet our objectives of raising the Art Center and our community's visibility in the region, and broaden the Art Center's audience.

In addition to the exhibition program achievements, the education staff presented 97 classes over four semesters serving 1,364 students. These classes served a range of individuals while also providing ongoing teacher certification and college credits for area educators. New this year as part of Project SOAR, a series of workshops for talented high school students, participants could earn college credit from Morningside College. Besides classes and workshops, the education program also provided 104 docent-led tours of the Art Center for 2,393 individuals of all ages, and two free workshops for the public. Finally, the Art Center's education and exhibition staff worked together with local educators to produce and distribute educational materials based on artworks from the Art Center's Permanent Collection to 70 area schools with the goal of creating a feeling of ownership of the Art Center and its collections.

As an integral part to both our exhibition and education programs, during the last year the Art Center added 12 new works to its Permanent Collection. In addition staff also identified eight artists with significant accomplishments and connections to our region to target for acquisition through the Art Center's Legacy collecting initiative. The collecting initiative reflects the Art Center's

collection plan and vision statement of growing and promoting the Art Center's collection as a cultural tourist destination point, as well as serving as a unique regional resource for students, educators and general public.

As part of our effort to build the collection, the Art Center's spring fundraiser not only raised funds for programs, it also included the purchase of an artwork for the Collection in honor of Wilson and Louise Persinger, James and Do Yanney, and Robert and Helen Jane Gleeson. In addition to having a successful spring fundraiser, our major fall fundraiser, Art Center's ArtSplash, was a huge success in spite of having to move from the riverfront to Grandview Park due to the recent flooding.

In addition to thanking all those who supported the Art Center during the last year (pages 18-19), I want to especially thank Security National Bank's Gilchrist Foundation, the Gardner Foundation, and the M. A. Martin Everist Foundation for their support of the Art Center over the years.

Last, but not least, I want to acknowledge and thank Mayor Michael Hobart and members of the City Council of Sioux City for their continuing support of the Art Center. I also want to thank and acknowledge the Board of Trustees, and the Art Center Association of Sioux City's Board of Directors for their volunteer service and efforts on behalf of the Art Center. It has been a pleasure to work closely with Doug Palmer, Chair of the Board of Trustees, and Jay Chesterman, President of the Art Center Association Board of Directors.

The Sioux City Art Center is truly a model public/private partnership.

I look forward to reporting to you on the Sioux City Art Center's FY 2011 – 2012 in our next Annual Report.

## Docent Program

Our team of nine dedicated volunteer docents consistently attended informative and educational tours given at the beginning of every new exhibition by the director/curator and studio program coordinator. We are extremely grateful to the docents for conducting 104 tours, serving 2,393 children and adults. Included in these numbers is the ARTworks program serving fifth-grade students who receive free busing, a guided tour and an opportunity to create a piece of artwork based on the Grant Wood murals.

## ARTworks Program

With funding from the Margaret Ann Martin Everist Education Initiative, the Art Center has worked closely with art teachers and docents to create new materials that will extend the field trip experience into the classroom. Featuring four artists in the Permanent Collection, educational posters have been made and distributed to elementary buildings in a 45-mile radius of Sioux City. A DVD that shows two students visiting the Art Center to find out what is in store for them when their class visits for its ARTworks tour is also included with the posters.

## Project SOAR

Student Opportunities for Art Research is intended for artistically-talented high school students who would enjoy and learn from an intense, 15-hour art workshop. This year's Project SOAR utilized the expertise of area artists and educators in ceramics, photography, drawing and painting mediums. Eighteen students from twelve schools took advantage of this program which is underwritten by the Art Center Association. Undergraduate credit was available through Morningside College.

## Youth Art Month

In celebration of Youth Art Month, the Sioux City Art Center held its 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Juried Youth Art Exhibition for area elementary schools, from February 26 – April 17, 2011. From the 469 pieces that were submitted, juror Mark Kochen chose 91 pieces from 30 elementary schools to show in the exhibition. The opening reception on Sunday, February 27 was extremely well received with 506 children and adults filling the Atrium. Mayor Michael Hobart, Superintendent Dr. Paul Gausman and Art Center Director Al Harris-Fernandez assisted in the presentation of awards.

## Community-requested Classes, Workshops and Outreach Programs

## Education Gallery

The William T. Dible Hallway and the Metz Education Hallway on the second floor have been designated as spaces for hanging artwork created by students and faculty at the Art Center. Artwork was displayed on a rotating basis throughout the year as well as bulletin boards with class schedules and other art related subjects, such as the elements and principals of art.

## Artful Birthday Parties

The Art Center has hosted 21 birthday parties in the past 12 months. Under the direction of our inventive teachers, 235 participants created fun projects and memories.

## ArtCamp 2010

This was the seventh year the Art Center has hosted ArtCamp. This year's camps were a huge success with 161 children attending, fifty more than the prior year. ArtCamp 2010 culminated in an exhibition of students' works and a reception on August 15th. The Education Gallery displayed 161 art projects, chosen by the students as their favorites, from August 15 – October 6.

## Classes and Workshops

During the 2010-11 quarterly semesters, 97 adult and children classes were taught at the Art Center. 1,364 students participated for a total of 6,259 teacher-student contact hours. Nearly all of the adult classes were available for graduate credit or teaching license renewal credit through Northwest AEA, Briar Cliff University and Morningside College.

## Holiday Gift Making Workshops

Our annual Holiday Workshops were held on December 4, 2010. Eight art projects and refreshments were offered free of charge to the public, with 150 children and adults participating under the guidance of five instructors.

## Spring Workshops

The Spring Workshops were held at the Art Center on April 16, 2011. Ninety-five children and adults had fun celebrating the arrival of spring by decorating eggs, tin decanters, making carrot trees, and bunny bean bags. A collaborative effort with St. Luke's Family Spirit Program, allowed the workshops to be free to the public.
