

# ANNUAL REPORT

July 1, 2009 - June 30, 2010

The Sioux City Art Center is a model public/private partnership between the City of Sioux City and the Art Center Association of Sioux City, with each contributing approximately one-half of the Art Center's annual operating budget. The Art Center, through its non-profit fundraising arm, leverages a dollar in private donations for each tax dollar it receives. Without this model partnership, the Sioux City Art Center could not achieve the quality programs and services that it provides our community and region.

In addition to directly serving more than 65,000 annual visitors through its exhibition and education programs, and its annual festival of the arts, Artsplash, the Art Center also plays an important role in our economy. As a symbol of our community's commitment to quality of life, the Art Center is used as an example for businesses to recruit new professionals and organizations to our city.

As part of our commitment to both serving and promoting our community, the Art Center adopted the following vision statement as part of its 2006 – 2010 Strategic Plan: *The Sioux City Art Center will raise the visibility of the Art Center and City by featuring major exhibitions, and building its permanent collection to include important art with significant links to the region, and utilizing its collection to create a valued educational resource.*

Since 2007 the Art Center has been working on implementing this vision through a new Blockbuster Partnership committed to continuing to bring in major traveling exhibitions and allocating funds for collecting through the Legacy Collection. Furthermore, the Art Center Association has committed funds for a new collecting effort through the Margaret Heffernan Acquisition Fund and the Unnamed Foundation, now the Gilchrist Foundation. In early FY 2007/2008 the Art Center received a \$100,000 grant from the M. A. Martin Everist Foundation to connect the collecting initiative with the vision of creating a regional educational resource. The result is the Margaret Ann

Martin Everist Permanent Collection Gallery and Educational Initiative.

The Educational Initiative was launched in July 2008 with a long-term exhibition of selected works from the Permanent Collection arranged in historical periods and movements and supported with a free catalog on these periods and movements, as well as 33 free brochures on individual artists featured in the exhibition.

The exhibition is also supported with a new study area adjacent to the exhibition gallery, featuring a non-circulating library of over 40 books and catalogs related to the Collection. During the past year staff has continued collaborating with area educators to produce educational materials on the Collection. As a result, the Art Center produced a DVD and four educational posters, featuring the Art Center and focusing on works from the Collection that will be used in classrooms to prepare students for a tour of the Art Center, as well as resource materials for classroom projects. Art Center staff is currently working with teachers from area high school teachers to develop additional materials. A major goal of the Education Initiative is to grow community pride in our area's artists and a feeling of ownership in the Art Center's Collection.

Along with the Legacy Collection program, the Margaret Ann Martin Everist Permanent Collection Gallery and Educational Initiative, the Art Center has continued its commitment of bringing major traveling exhibitions to the community, while also featuring area artists. In 2010 the Blockbuster II Partnership sponsored the seventh major traveling exhibition in seven years by underwriting *America the Beautiful: The Monumental Landscape of Clyde Butcher*. The exhibition featured 65 large-format photographs, some as large as 5 x 9 feet. Butcher's stunning images capture, and promote the conservation of America's unspoiled public lands. In addition to presenting the seventh Blockbuster exhibition, the Art Center also scheduled its next major traveling exhibition, *Leonardo da Vinci: Man,*

*Artist, Inventor, Genius*, to run from July 14 – October 14, 2012.

While all the blockbuster exhibitions have raised the visibility of our community and attracted visitors from across the region by leaving them with wonderful impressions, *America the Beautiful* will have a more lasting impact due to Mr. Butcher's donation of one of his outstanding artworks to our Permanent Collection. Along with Mr. Butcher's donation, the Art Center added 22 other artworks to the Collection. Four of which were the result of a gift by Irving and Carolyn Jensen to purchase four photographs by Charles W. Guildner. (For a list of new accessions to the Collection see page 15)

While these are some of the highlights of the last fiscal year, they are just part of the many activities offered by the Sioux City Art Center as you will see while looking through the following Annual Report.

Last but not least, I want to acknowledge and thank the Mayor Michael Hobart and members of the City Council of Sioux City for their continuing support of the Art Center. I also want to thank and acknowledge the Board of Trustees, and the Art Center Association of Sioux City's Board of Directors for their volunteer service and efforts on behalf of the Art Center. It has been a pleasure to work closely with Doug Palmer, Chair of the Board of Trustees, and Kent Vriezelaar, President of the Art Center Association Board of Directors.

The Sioux City Art Center is truly a model public/private partnership.

I look forward to reporting to you on the Sioux City Art Center's FY2010 – 2011 in our next Annual Report.

Holiday Gift Making Workshops

## Docent Program

Eleven volunteer docents attended special informative and educational tours given at the beginning of every exhibition. The docents then conducted 111 tours, serving 2330 children and adults.

## Artist-in-Residence '09

Thirteen high schools students worked with four artist/educators in week-long summer workshops. A student exhibition featuring the student work ran from August 1 through September 13, 2009. The A.I.R. program changed its name in 2010 to *Project SOAR (Student Opportunities for Artistic Research)*. Twenty-seven students from twelve schools took advantage of the program.

## Youth Art Month

In celebration of Youth Art Month, the Sioux City Art Center held its 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Juried *Youth Art Exhibition, High School*, from February 27 – April 18, 2010. The exhibition featured one hundred eleven artworks by from 14 high schools in the Siouxland area.

## Youth Art Collection

A new youth art purchase award program will help create a collection of student art at the Sioux City Art Center. Artwork by five area high school students were purchased of the collection.

## Margaret Ann Martin Everist Education Initiative

Started in 2007, the goal of this multi phase plan is to seek input from area educators and develop tools to facilitate knowledge of art works in the Sioux City Art Center's Permanent Collection. As a result shared vocabularies, educational posters and a CD have been developed for fifth grade teachers.

## Education Gallery

The William T. Dible Hallway and the Metz Education Hallway on the second floor featured several exhibitions of student work produced in Art Center classes.

## Artful Birthday Parties

The Art Center has hosted 19 Artful Birthday Parties in the last twelve months. Under the direction of our inventive teachers, 251 participants created fun projects and memories.

## ArtCamp 2009

The annual camp is for children ages 6 – 12. The five, two-week sessions served 125 children. ArtCamp '09 culminated in an exhibition of students' works and a reception on August 16.

## Classes and Workshops

During the 09-10 quarterly semesters, 88 adult and children classes were taught at the Art Center. 1,023 students participated for a total of 8,911.5 teacher-student contact hours. Nearly all of the adult classes were available for graduate credit or teaching license renewal credit through Northwest AEA, Briar Cliff University and Morningside College.

## Butcher Family Fun Day

Based on the exhibition *America and Beautiful: Monumental Landscape of Clyde Butcher*, a free family day was held on December 13, 2009. Ninety people attended the event that included viewing the show and then doing a value study of a landscape.

## Holiday Gift Making Workshops

Our annual Holiday Workshops were held on December 5, 2009. Eight art projects and refreshments were offered free of charge to 145 children and adults who participated.

## Spring Workshops

Were held at the Art Center on April 11, 2009. 68 children and adults participated.

## June E. Nylén Cancer Center classes

The Art Center and Cancer Center collaborated on a project to offer classes to patients of the Cancer Center. The classes began on April 6, 2009 and culminated on April 27, 2010. Fifty-seven students participated throughout the year.

## ARTSPASH 2010 UPDATE

ArtSplash 2010 highlighted the best of Sioux City and gave back to our community. In the Children's Area, families enjoyed creative activities and projects provided by 9 local non-profit groups, and the Sioux City Art Center and the Sioux City Community Theatre. ArtSplash also helped the winners of the Sand Sculpture competition raise funds for their dance team, supported Western Iowa Tech's Police Science Club, and supported the Cosmopolitan Club with their fight to cure diabetes. In fact, over \$20,000 of the ArtSplash budget went to support 19 local non-profit groups and help them carry out their missions in our community.

Additionally, ArtSplash invited four new local food vendors to join this year's festival. Several local performers contributed to the 18 hours of fantastic talent on both the Main Stage and in the Children's Loft, and 350 local volunteers spent over 2,000 hours at the festival.

TalentSplash, Rockestra and Salsabrosa rocked the Main Stage and lively strolling performers entertained the crowds. Those that browsed the juried art show raved about the selection of art available from 85 outstanding artists. The many art activities in the Children's Area and Hands on for Bigger Hands booth provided cost-effective opportunities for festival-goers to exercise their own creativity as well.

This year's festival was an especially good "buy" for families on tight budgets. Where else could you enjoy two full days of family-friendly entertainment for \$5 per person with children 11 and under getting in free? In addition to providing affordable entertainment for Siouxlans locals, ArtSplash also brought approximately \$1.5 million into Sioux City with out-of-town guests staying in hotels, buying meals, visiting local attractions and shopping!
